

Graduation Requirements (effective through the Class of 2010)

Subject Area	Courses Required	Credits Required
Language Arts	English I, II, III, IV, and Speech	4 ½
Mathematics	Algebra I, Geometry, Algebra II, and one additional math	4
Science	Biology, and two additional sciences (one with lab)	3
Social Studies	World History, American History, and Government/Economics	3
Foreign Language	Two consecutive years of the same language	2
Bible	One year of Bible for each year at TMA	4
Physical Education	Personal Fitness/Life Management, or HOPE, and 1 additional PE credit (2 seasons of a varsity sport, junior varsity sport, or marching band may substitute for the 1 additional PE credit)	2
Fine Arts	Any approved Fine Arts courses	1
Electives	Any approved electives	½

*** Dual Enrollment**

- All dual enrollment math courses have a pre-requisite of Algebra II; Calculus has the additional pre-requisite of Pre-Calculus
- All dual enrollment classes require a 970 SAT (Critical Reading and Math), or 21 ACT (Composite) score; a 3.0 un-weighted GPA is also required
- Students that have not taken the SAT or ACT, or who do not meet the score criteria, may still take the class. Students may take the SAT or ACT while enrolled in the class, and the score can be used to satisfy the requirement. However, students will only receive college credit if they meet the score criteria.
