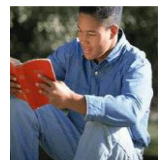

SAT Testing

I read an article about children and sleep this week. It emphasized that children do better in school, the brain functions better, weight is better controlled, and overall health is improved when a child has enough sleep. Sleep loss makes the brain less coordinated and efficient -- and it doesn't take much to have an impact. Skipping only one hour of nightly sleep for just a week can have a significant effect on kids' ability to concentrate. Have a particularly accident-prone child? Take a closer look at sleep habits. Tired kids have twice as many injuries as their well-rested peers, say scientists at the University of Rochester School of Nursing.
