

NEW TMA Traffic Patterns

Per the Seminole County Sheriff, changes are necessary to our traffic flow when entering TMA property. They have advised us that **they will be ticketing** so I wanted to warn you of their requirements. I can foresee that we'll have to allot ourselves extra time in the mornings because the change they require will cause some longer lines in the process. We'll begin the change on Monday.

I also want to remind you if you'd like to avoid all of this....**TMA provides a free shuttle bus from the Home Depot Shopping Center every morning.** TMA's yellow bus leaves promptly at 7:25 a.m. from the parking lot near Citizens Bank of Florida. You'd probably want to be there around 7:20 a.m. to catch the shuttle.

So, here is the new information: (**Please review the diagrams attached to this e-mail**)

After reviewing TMA's current traffic plan, the Seminole County Sheriff's department will **NO LONGER ALLOW US TO USE 2 LANES ON LUKAS LANE** as entrance lanes since there is a double yellow line on that road. That is a county owned road and they said we CANNOT continue our current driving plan of having a lower school entrance lane and an upper school entrance lane.

So, starting **Monday, October 6th**, we have to go with a new plan. In both the morning and the afternoon, we can only have ONE LANE of traffic entering onto Lukas Lane because of that double yellow line. About 1/3 of the way down Lukas Lane, the double yellow line is gone and at that point we can divide into lower school lanes and upper school lanes as usual. Everything else remains the same.

Please be patient and courteous with each other as we all work through the logistics of this new plan. Our advice to each family is to leave your home a little earlier than you normally would so we have built in time to be patient and kind! Plus, you don't want a \$141 ticket.
